Knowledge, skills and abilities:

Essential:

- Experience of working with children and young people.
- Excellent people skills and the ability to engage with people from a wide variety of ages, backgrounds and experience
- Able to communicate the Christian faith and teachings at age appropriate levels.
- Able to demonstrate a clear passion for working with, supporting and engaging with children and young people (aged 0-18)
- Desire and ability to pioneer new groups and take advantage of new opportunities
- Excellent organisational skills
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to use IT efficiently for administrative tasks
- Able to demonstrate creativity in communicating in interactive, engaging and relevant ways
- Working knowledge of General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Clear understanding of safeguarding practices

Desirable:

- Training in children and/or youth work/ministry
- Experience of leading previous children and/or youth ministry work
- Experience of Churchsuite (Church administration software)
- Capable of designing basic flyers / posters
- Experience creating resources and materials for a children/youth context
- First Aid and/or Mental Health First Aid training

Personal Attributes

- There is a genuine occupational requirement that the postholder be a committed follower of Jesus.
- Passionate, enthusiastic, teachable and willing to learn
- A mature and sensitive manner in dealing with a number of members of the public, and in fostering good relationships with children, young people and their parents/carers/grandparents, as well as with volunteers and members of the church and wider community
- A capacity to work on your own and as part of a team, confident to take the initiative
- The ability to handle multiple tasks, prioritise and work to deadlines
